We are remaining open but due to the continued concern and safety regarding COVID-19, we will be reducing our appointment hours beginning March 30th until further notice.

New treatment hours are as follows:

We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause you.

We are committed to providing a safe and healthy clinic for you to visit. Here are some of the things we are doing:

- ✓ We have stepped up our normal cleaning and disinfecting routine.
- ✓ We have streamlined your visit to minimize your contact with surfaces.
- ✓ We are screening patients before they come for any symptoms of COVID 19 and for any situations where they would be in contact with someone with COVID 19.
- ✓ We are spacing out appointments more to minimize your contact with other patients.
- ✓ We have removed toys and magazines from our reception area.
- ✓ We will waive any fees for cancellations. Please contact us if you will be unable to make your appointment.

Here's what you can do to help us in creating a safe, healthy visit:

- We request patients to not bring siblings, friends, or relatives to your appointment; and only one parent, rather than both, attend with a child.
- Try to limit what you touch in the office. We will try to bring you back to a treatment room as soon as possible.

We would ask that you please stay home if you:

- Have a fever
- Have a cough
- Have a respiratory infection

- Have a new sore throat
- Have shortness of breath
- Have been diagnosed with COVID 19
- Are waiting to be tested for COVID 19
- Have been in contact with anyone that has or may have COVID 19
- Have traveled on an airplane in the past two weeks.

We would ask that you consider your specific risk factors to developing a serious COVID 19 infection and possibly stay home if your history includes:

- ✓ Respiratory or pulmonary disease
- ✓ Smoking
- ✓ Immune deficiency
- ✓ Chronic illness
- ✓ History of heart disease
- ✓ Diabetes
